




Fig.1 Typical output characteristic  $I_C=f(V_{CE})$ 




Fig.2 Typical output characteristic  $I_C=f(V_{CE}),\, T_{vi}=150\,^{\circ}{\rm C}$ 





Fig.3 Typical transfer characteristic  $I_C=f(V_{GE}), V_{CE}=20V$ 

Fig.4 Typical  $I_F$  as a function of  $V_F$   $I_F=f(V_F)$ 









Fig.5 Typical  $V_{GE(th)}$  as a function of  $T_{vj}$  $V_{GE(th)}$ = $f(T_{vj})$ ,  $I_C$ =250 $\mu$ A







Fig.7 Typical  $V_F$  as a function of  $T_{vj}$  $V_F=f(T_{vj})$ 

Fig.8 Typical Turn-off switching loss energy as a function of  $R_{\mbox{\scriptsize G}}$ 










Typical Turn-off switching loss energy as a Fig.9 function of I<sub>C</sub>

Fig.10 Typical Gate charge  $V_{GE}=f(Q_G), I_C=20A$ 






Fig.11  $C=f(V_{CE})$ , f=1MHz,  $V_{GE}=0V$











Fig.13 Forward bias safe operating area of IGBT  $T_c=25^{\circ}\text{C}, T_{vi}\leq175^{\circ}\text{C}, V_{GE}=15\text{V}$ 

Fig.14 Transient thermal impedance of IGBT  $Z_{th(j-c)}=f(t_p), D=t_p/T$ 








Fig.15 Transient thermal impedance of Diode  $Z_{th(j-c)}=f(t_p), D=t_p/T$
